This two to three hour workshop will give participants an introduction to qualitative research with MAXQDA. They will learn what type of data they can analyze with MAXQDA and gain an understanding of the basic options of coding and retrieving data, and searching for words or word combinations with the lexical search. Participants will also learn about the visualization options to check data for code patterns and relationships.

MAXQDA is a professional software for qualitative and mixed methods data analysis. It can be used to analyze e.g. interviews, literature, surveys, websites, social media, focus groups, audio/video, or tables.
